ANTICIPATED AIRPORT SHUTDOWN UPDATE

Alpine Casparis Municipal Airport is set to begin our Texas Department of Transportation CSJ. No. 2224ALPIN project for airport lighting improvements. The project consists of replacing lights along 01/19, NAVAID, and signage Improvements. The tentative start date for on-site construction has been pushed back and is now set to begin on the first of March 2023, with an anticipated completion date yet to be determined. Contractors will obtain all the materials for the job before commencing work to create fewer issues with the sporadic opening and closing of runways.

During the project on runway 01/19, however, both runways will still need to be closed for an estimated one (1) to three (3) weeks once construction along the intersection of runway 05/23 and 01/19 begins. NOTAMS will be posted to keep everyone informed as well as signs within the terminal. During runway closures, helicopters not flying the approaches will be able to land and depart during this project as allowed by their company/personal rules and regulations. We appreciate your patience as the timetable of this project has fluctuated. More information will be available as we reach the tentative start date. If you have any questions, please let us know.
