LEAD & COPPER RULE

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) announced final revisions to the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations for lead and copper under the authority of the Safe Drinking Water Act on December 16, 2021.

The Lead and Copper Rule (LCR) protects public health by minimizing lead and copper levels in drinking water, primarily by reducing corrosion of plumbing materials. This rule applies to all community water systems and non-transient non-community water systems.

Over the course of the next few months, the City of Alpine will have staff that will be conducting water service line inventory. This will include verification of current materials installed on both the public and private sides of the installed water meter. If you see Alpine City Staff Workers conducting this inventory outside of the normal 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM time period, please do not be alarmed. This includes weekends as well. Thank you for your patience and understanding.
