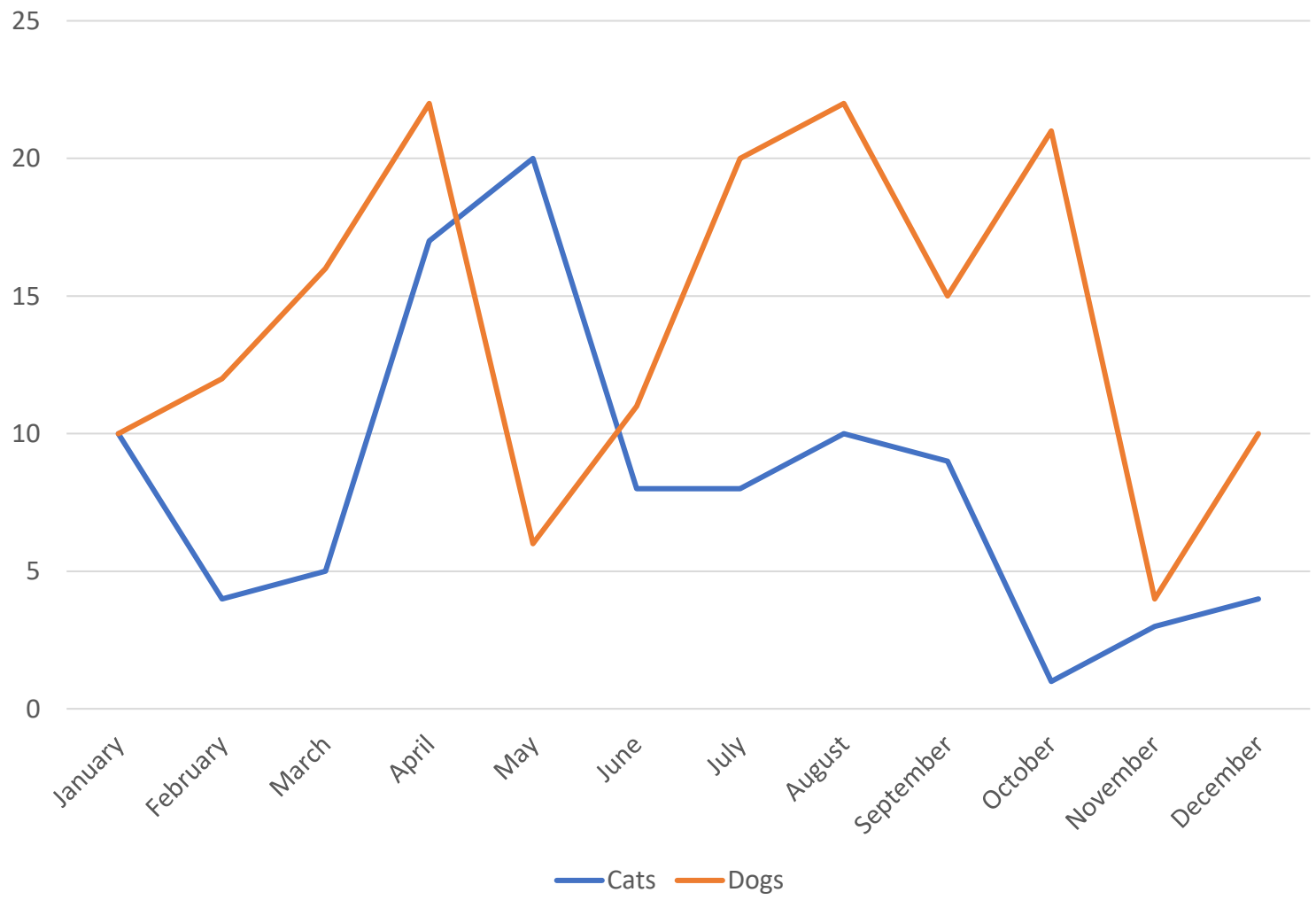

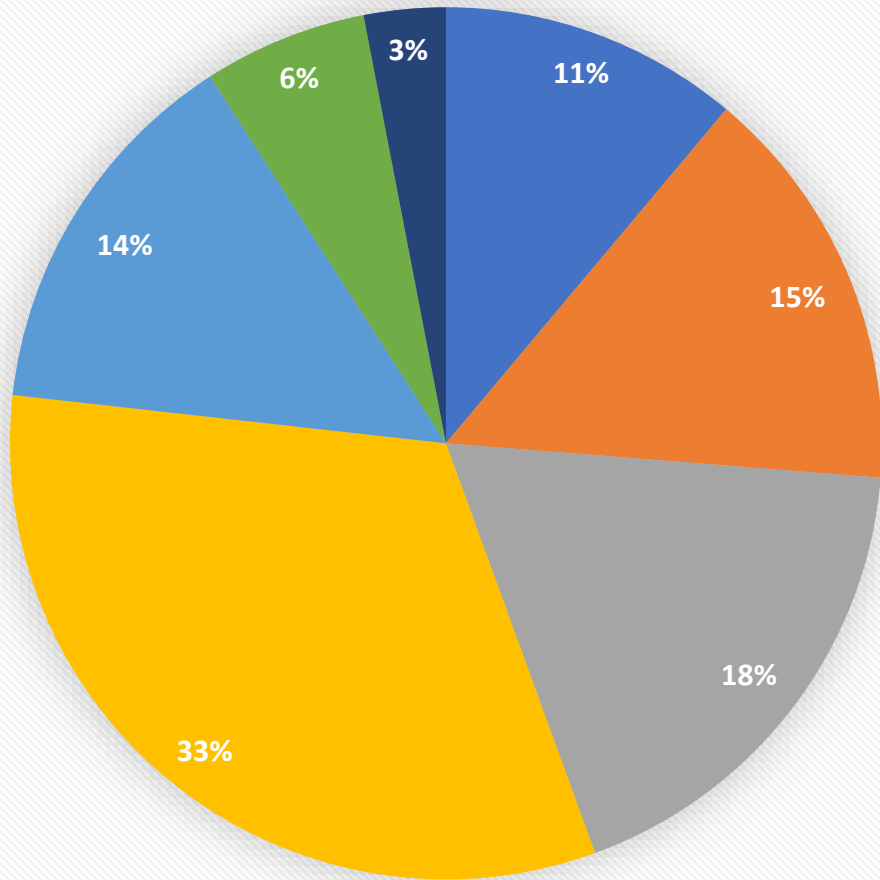

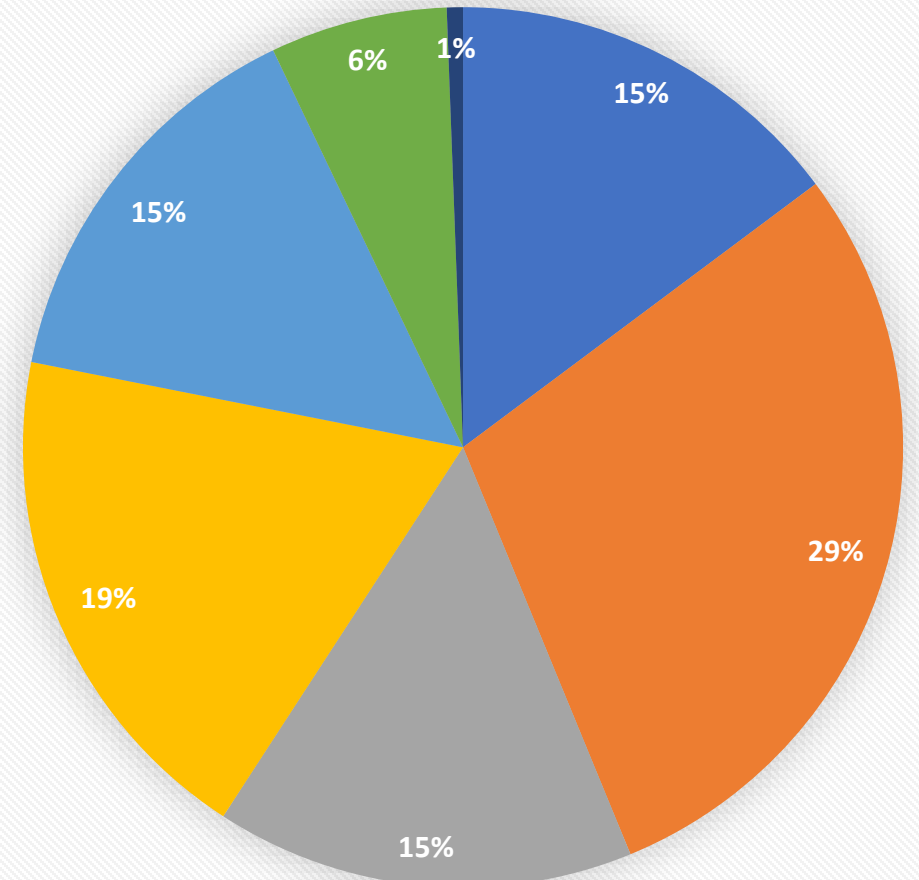
# Stray Intakes by Ward

## Cats



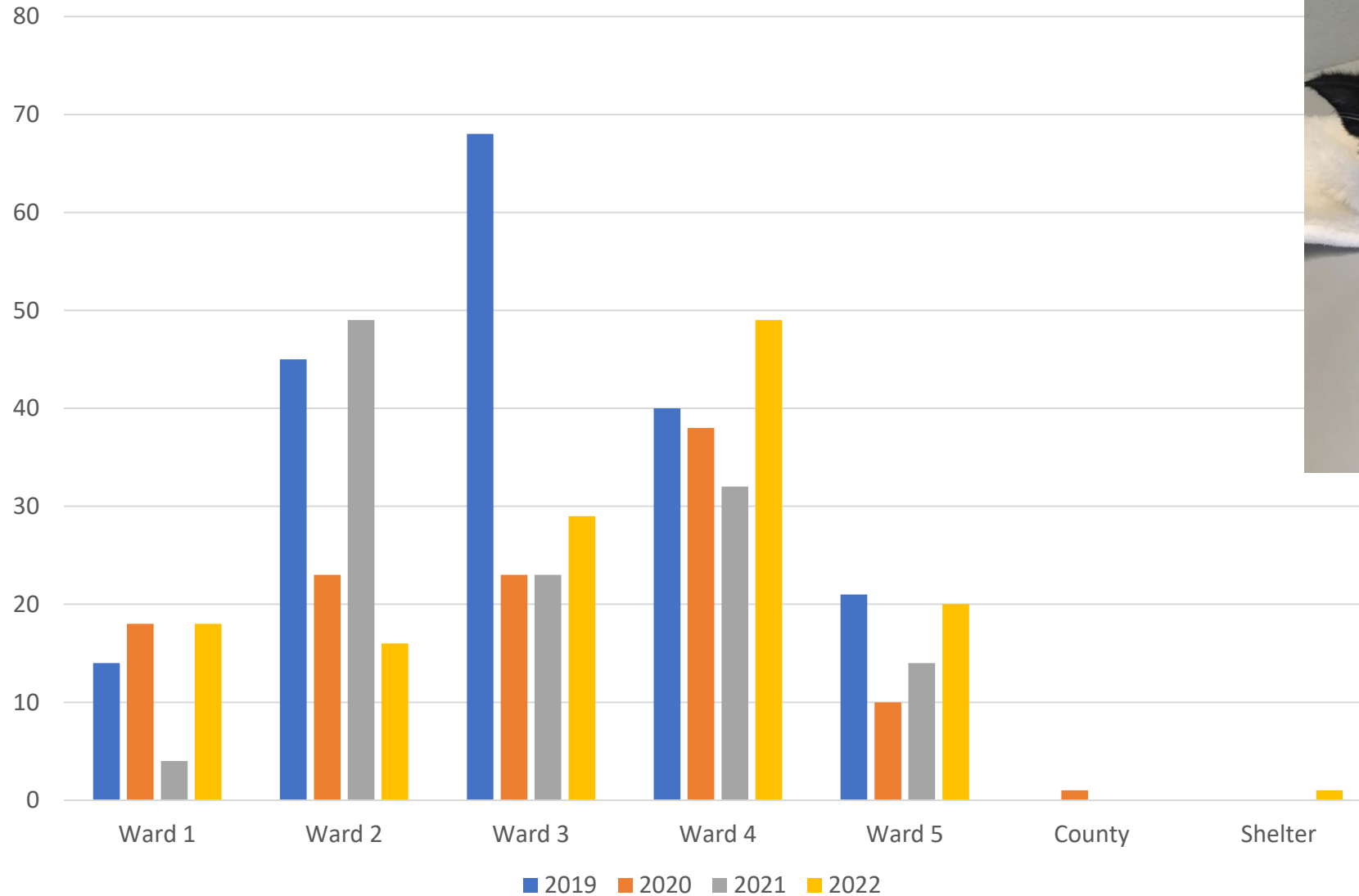
■ Ward 1 ■ Ward 2 ■ Ward 3 ■ Ward 4 ■ Ward 5 ■ County ■ SRSU

# Surrenders



- We had 42 total surrenders
- 15 cats and 27 dogs

# Other Intakes

- Total brought in due to owner medical emergency: 1 dog from county, 19 chickens and 4 dogs from Ward 4, 1 dog from ward 3 owner did not reclaim, 1 dog from County due to car accident relative reclaimed.
- Total brought in due to arrest: 2 dogs from Ward 5, owner did not reclaim
- Total brought in for quarantine: 15 dogs
- Total born in care: 6 kittens, 7 puppies





# Returned to Owner

- Out of 268 stray intakes, 137 were returned to owner
- 128 dogs
- 8 cats
- 1 chicken





# Adoptions

- We had 120 Adoptions
- 57 Cats
- 50 Dogs
- 13 Chickens







## Transports

- We transported 88 animals to other rescues
- 58 Cats
- 30 Dogs





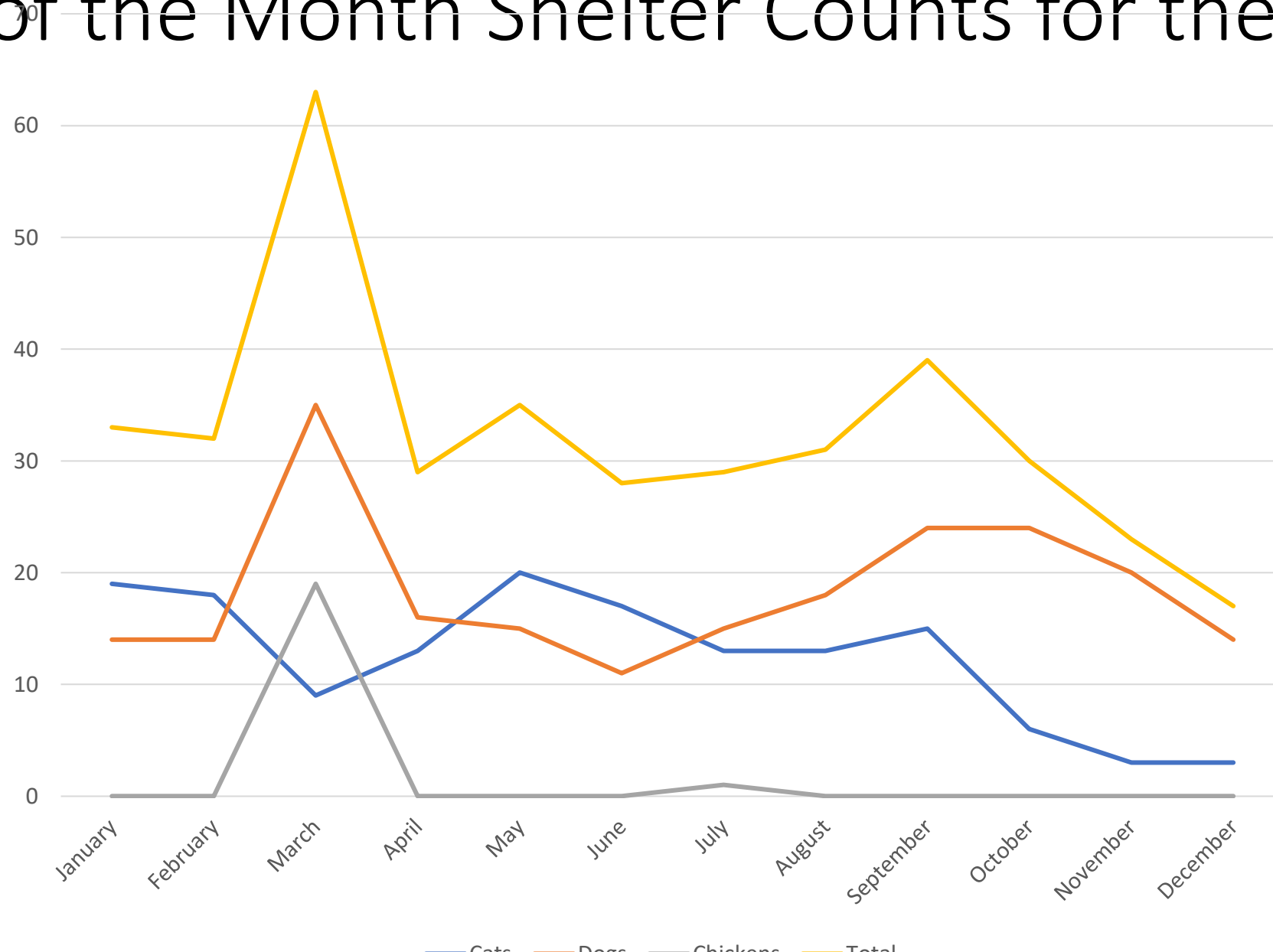

## Other Outcomes

- Total animals who died in care: 10 kittens due to illness, 1 dog due to old age
- Total number of animals euthanized not including feral cats: 2 kittens due to illness, 1 young cat due to illness, 2 adult cats due to illness, 3 dogs after bite incident not reclaimed, 2 dogs due to unadoptability

# Microchipping

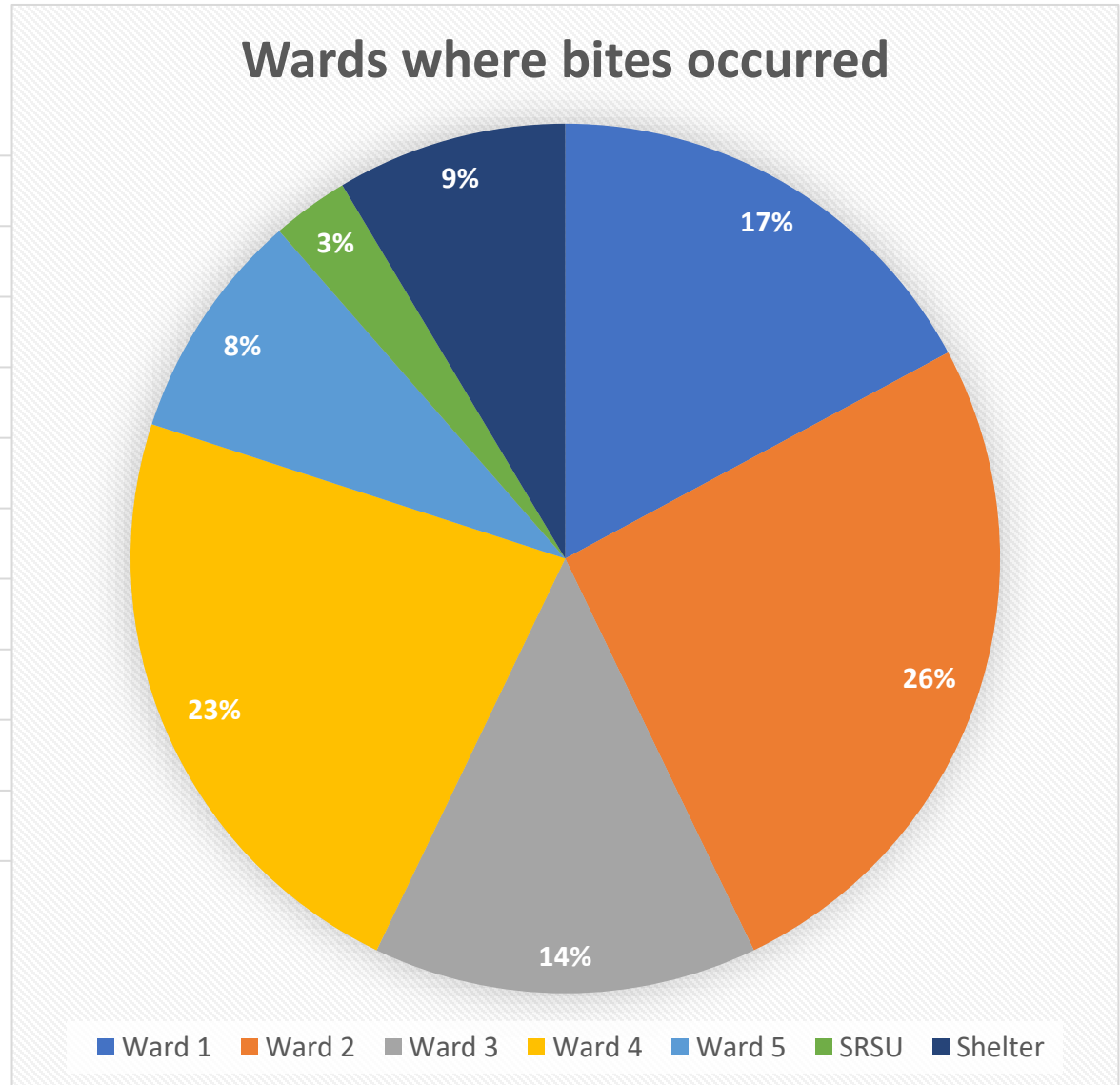
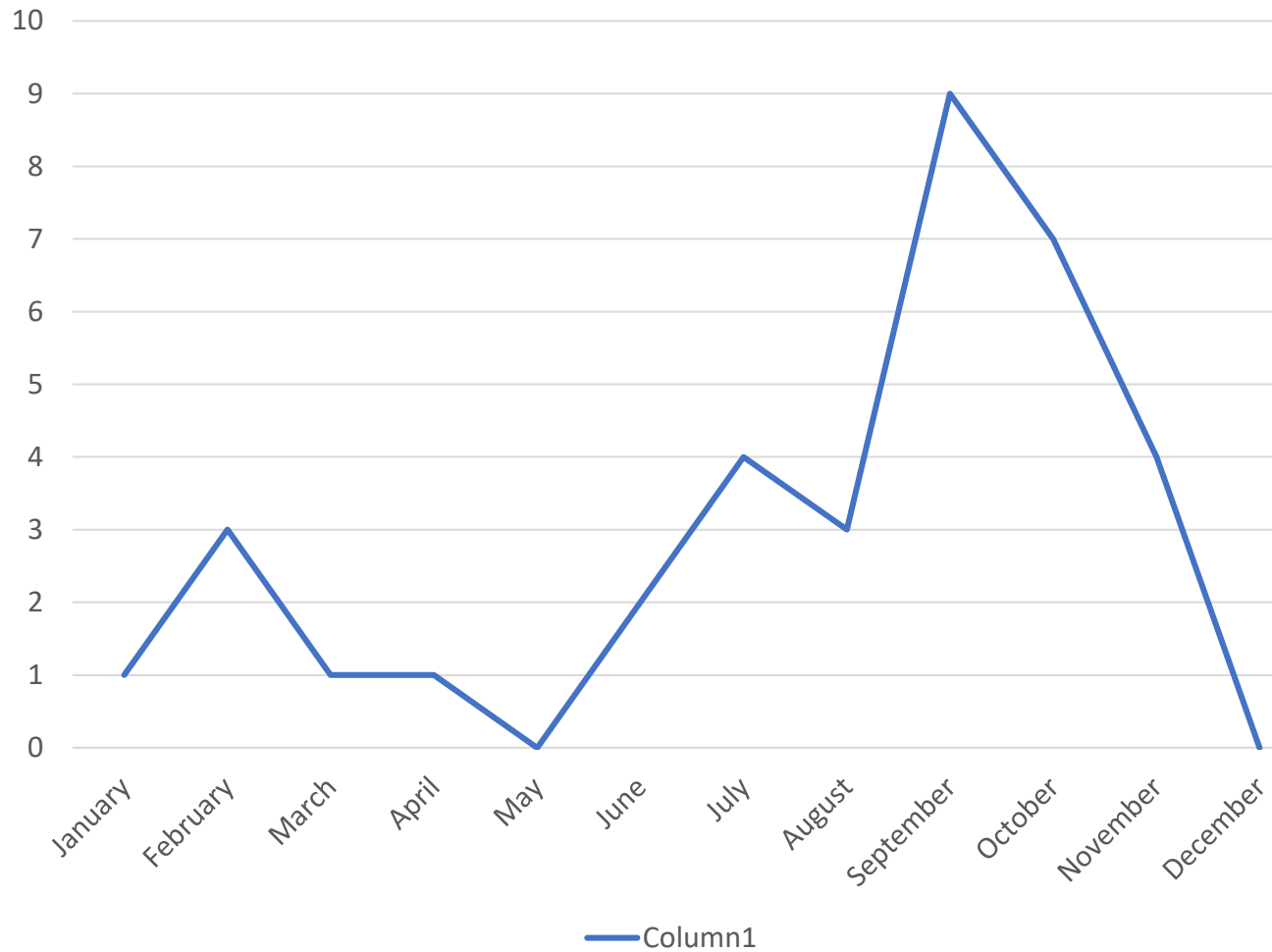
We placed 32 total microchips

# Animal Bites this year

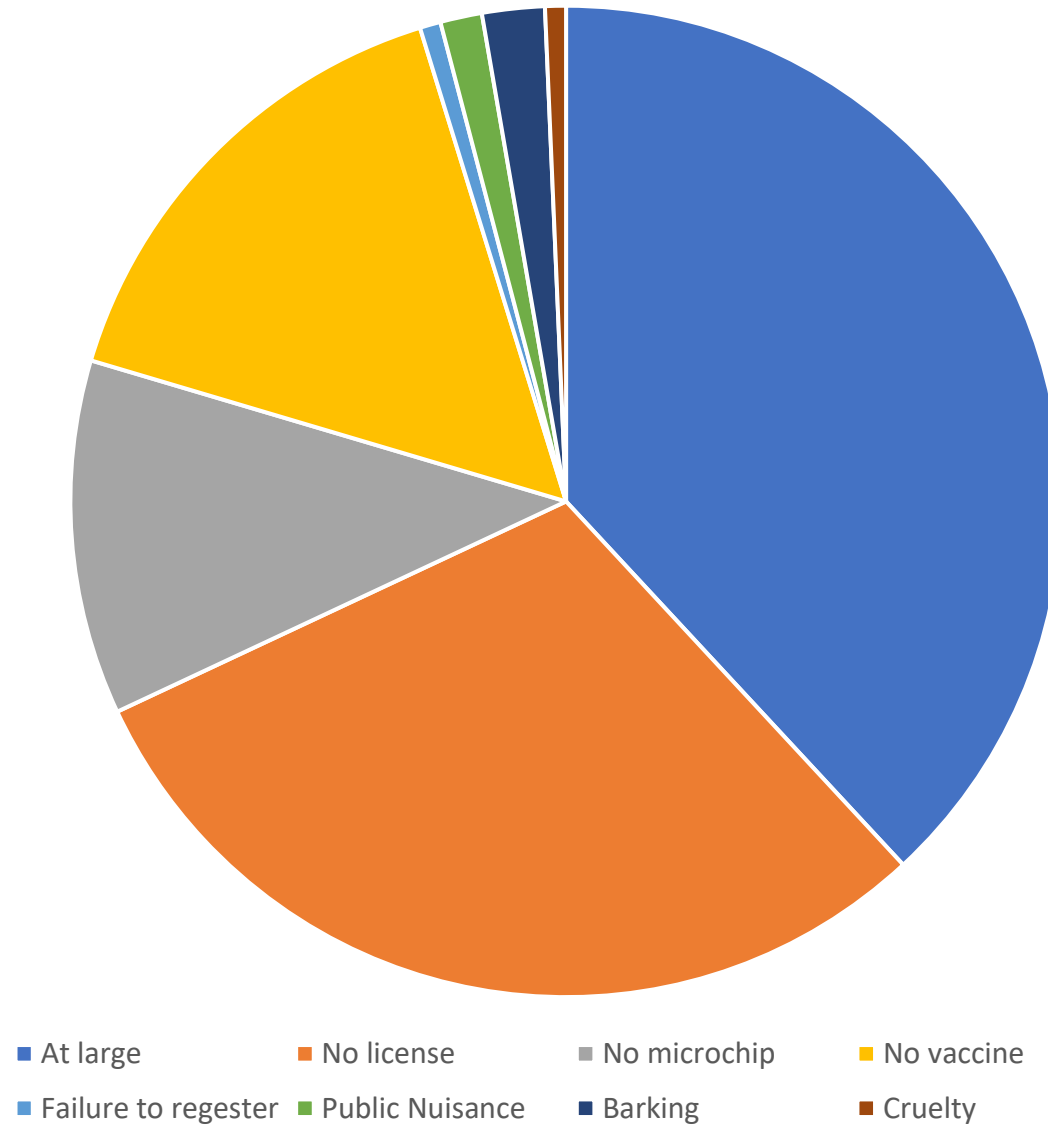




# Citations

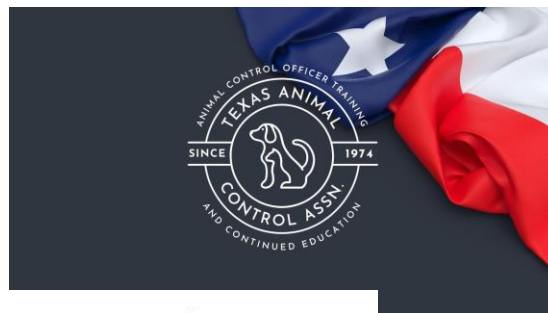
