As per our City Ordinance: Ord. No.2010-10-05, 1-11-11, Sec. 82-47. Bulky Waste Disposal

HOW TO:

1. CALL AHEAD (see calendar above)
2. PLACE UP TO **5 ITEMS OR 3 CUBIC YARDS** (*Anything in excess of 3 CUBIC YARDS will not be collected*). DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF YOUR HOUSE BY 10:00 PM ON SUNDAY NIGHT
3. **DO NOT PLACE ANYTHING ON THE STREET, SIDEWALK, ALLEY, OR NEXT TO THE DUMPSTER**
Anything left in these areas will be reported as **ILLEGAL DUMPING!**
4. KEEP ITEMS SEPARATED IN PILES (bulky waste/metal/yard waste, etc)

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- a) FURNITURE, MATTRESSES, LARGE PLASTIC TOYS
- b) APPLIANCES, WATER HEATERS, SCRAP METAL
REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS, & AIR CONDITIONERS WILL ONLY BE PICKED UP IF THE FREON HAS BEEN REMOVED BY A LICENSED TECHNICIAN WITH STICKER ATTACHED
- c) YARD WASTE - LEAVES, GRASS CLIPPINGS, AND OTHER SMALL CLIPPINGS **IN PAPER WASTE BAGS** CUT BRUSH & TREE LIMBS INTO PIECES LESS THAN (4) FOUR FEET LONG AND **BUNDLED WITH STRING OR TWINE** (NO WIRE)

EXCLUDES:

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS / TIRES / ELECTRONICS / HAZARDOUS MATERIALS **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**

If you missed the Bulky pick-up, please bring it to the Recycling Center and dispose of it for **FREE**.
