# Notable calls

## Sunny Glenn Structure Fire

- Residence became engulfed in flames. Firefighters were able to extinguish the flame and save several rooms in the structure. No individuals were harmed.
- Request made for assistance from Marathon Fire
- Water was brought in via Tanker





# Notable calls

## Structure fire in residence

- Resident trapped in home
- With help from Alpine Police Legaretta, and brave bystanders, pulled individual out and to safety.
- Individual still in critical condition
- Saved a majority of the trailer and all surrounding structures
- Matter is still under investigation



# Notable training

## Training at Jackson Field

- Firefighters were taught how to refill trucks from a stationary water source
- This is very useful in rural areas without hydrants
- Uses Tanker as a relay for hydrant water



# Future plans

- Plans moving forward to deploy our computer system
- Upgrade trucks with new digital radios
- Get rescue equipment serviced
- Upgrade our supply of handheld equipment
