

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


'It is now time to open Texas 100%:' Texas Gov. Greg Abbott reverses statewide pandemic orders

COVID RISK LEVEL ①

At risk of outbreak

Brewster County is at risk of an outbreak. COVID cases are either increasing at a rate likely to overwhelm hospitals and/or the state's COVID preparedness is below international standards.



ALERT

In February 2021, Texas experienced extreme winter weather that impacted many aspects of daily life, including COVID testing and vaccination. We expect it to take many weeks for testing to recover. In the meantime, our Daily New Cases and Infection Rate metrics should be treated with caution.


Updated the 11-Step Process for Vacating, Closure, Abandonment and Purchase of City-Owned property

 Currently do not have any lots approved by Council for sale, but always something that the CM can review with City Council to understand what opportunities are available









Retrofit for Holding Cells

Chief Martin is working with Brandon Wood, the Executive Director for the Texas Commission on Jail Standards

- Holding cells in municipal police departments are not required to comply with Minimum Jail Standards.
 When we have counties that construct something similar, it would be classified as a lock up and those standards can be found at: Texas Administrative Code (state.tx.us)
- And the Life Safety Section: <u>Texas Administrative Code (state.tx.us)</u>

 While we were probably hoping to learn that they just have to be built of CMU block with a lock, its much more involved than that. Chief Martin has a follow-up call scheduled with Brandon Wood to review the details further
