

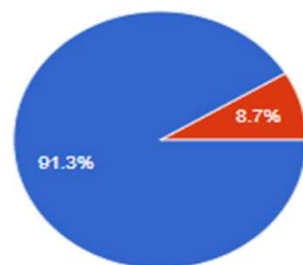

Do you live within the City limits of Alpine?

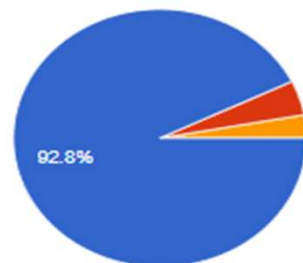

Do you pay residential or commercial sanitation rates?

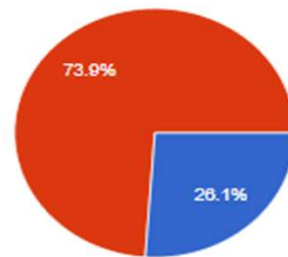

Would you prefer Poly-carts or dumpsters? (Poly-carts are a single 95 gallon plastic cart - image below)

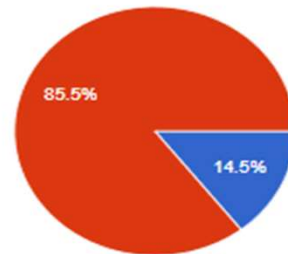

Are you willing to pay more monthly for poly-carts?

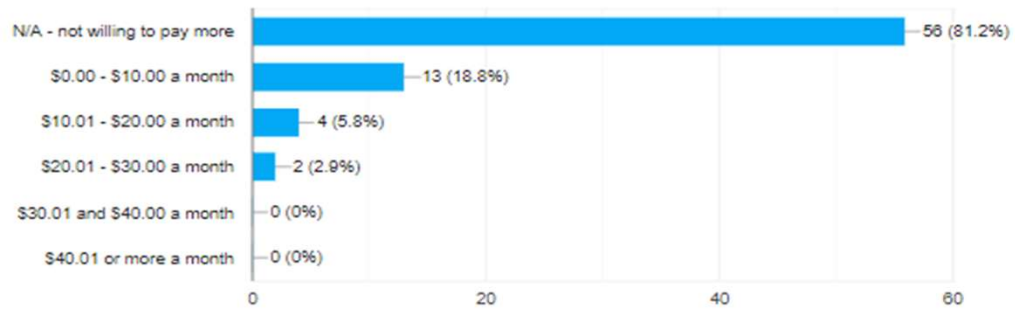

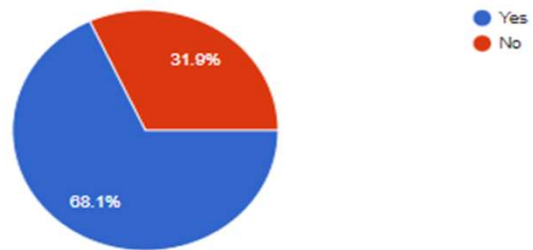
If yes, how much more would you be willing to pay over the current rate? (Please check all that apply)

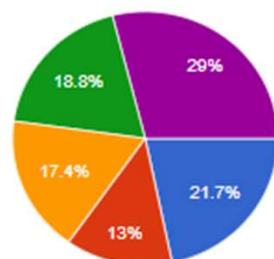
Do you recycle?

How often do you recycle?

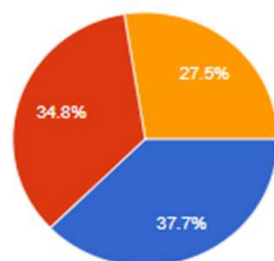

Which method of recycling would you prefer?

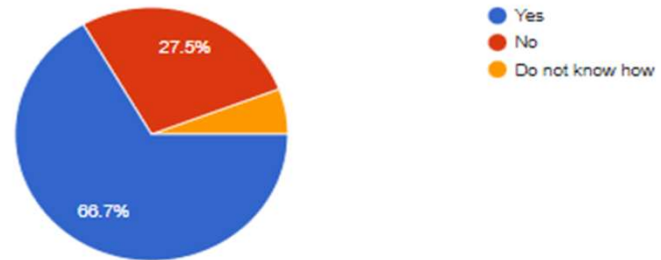

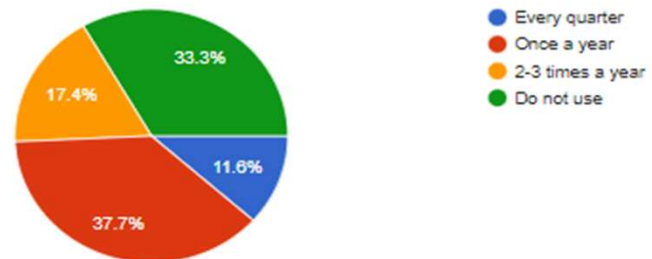
Do you utilize the bulky pickup services?

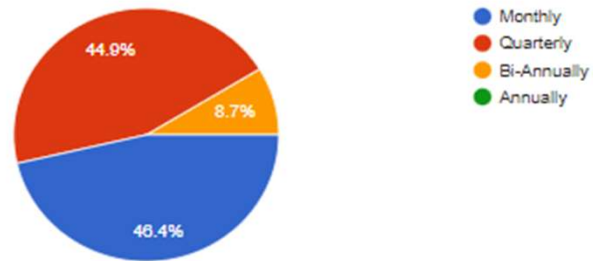
How often do you utilize the quarterly bulky pickup services?

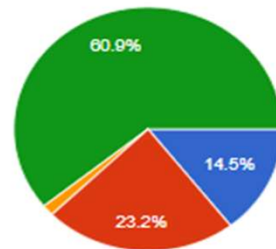
If you do not use the bulky pickup services - how do you dispose of larger household items?

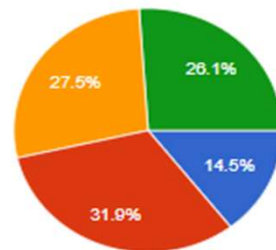

Illegal Dumping has become a growing issue within the City of Alpine. Below are several opportunities to address illegal dumping AND ESTIMATED ASSOCIATED COST PER HOUSEHOLD. Please select ONE opportunity you would support.

- No additional measures (Zero additional costs)
- Increase bulky pick up from quarterly to monthly (approximately \$5.00 more a month per household)
- Hiring of two (2) additional staff dedicated to the clean up of illegal dumping (approximately \$6.00 more a month per household)
- Additional Community Clean Up Events (Zero additional costs - Requires community support)

- Grants WITH City Financial Obligations – ACTIVE
 - TXDOT Aviation – RAMP (Routine Airport Maintenance Program) – 50% matching of qualified maintenance expenses
 - TXDOT Aviation – Lighting Project – 10% match (\$95,000) – Pending Payment
 - TXDOT Aviation – Seal Coat Project – 10 % match (\$59,000) – paid in FY 2021
 - TPWD – Pueblo Nuevo Park – 50% match – (\$217,300)
