Drought Contingency – Mild Conditions

Voluntary Restrictions Continued

- Over 4th of July weekend
 - Power outage – unable to move water, monitored continuously to ensure storage tanks levels adequate
 - Power restored – two wells no longer operational (Terry 2 and Roberts 5)
 - Team working with vendors for parts to repair
- Possible Insurance Claim – pending paperwork and supporting documentation



HOT Funds

- Review of current accounts
 - Accounting Software – removal of closed HOT accounts
 - Tourism Director - Chris Ruggia assisting with Comptroller listing of HOT payees to verify with City
 - Notification of past due or inactivity to payees – verify operation still open
 - Final list of past due accounts and supporting documentation to be provided to City Attorney
- Council Approval to move forward with legal actions – if necessary
