2021-22 QUARTERLY BULK PICK-UP SCHEDULE

OCTOBER 11TH, 2021

JANUARY 10th, 2022 - APRIL 11TH, 2022 - JULY 11TH, 2022

Residents will need to schedule a pick-up during the week prior of the collection event:

Oct 2021 - Monday 10/4/2021 - Friday 10/8/2021

Jan 2022 - Monday 1/3/2022 - Friday 1/7/2022

Apr 2022 - Monday 4/4/2022 - Friday 4/8/2022

Jul 2022 - Monday 7/4/2022 - Friday 7/8/2022

ONLY ITEMS CALLED IN THE WEEK BEFORE WILL BE PICKED-UP

Do not place anything on the street or sidewalk, in an alley, or next to the dumpster. Keep items separated in piles of bulky waste, metal, or yard waste. Beginning at 7:00 am on the day of quarterly bulk pick-up, Texas Disposal Systems Crews will pick up ONLY bulky trash and items that were called in the week prior.

- Any items set out without being scheduled for pick up will be considered illegal dumping -

Acceptable Items include (limit of 5 items per household):

- Furniture, mattresses, large plastic yard toys
- Appliances, water heaters, and scrap metal --- **Refrigerators, freezers, & air conditioners will only be picked up if the Freon has been removed by a licensed technician whose sticker is attached.**
- Yard waste --- Put leaves, grass clippings, and other small trimmings in paper yard waste bags. Cut brush & tree limbs into pieces no longer than 4 feet, & bundle them with string or twine (no wire).

EXCLUDES

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS, TIRES, ELECTRONICS, AND HAZARDOUS MATERIALS!

NEVER PLACE TRASH NEXT TO DUMPSTERS!

You may bring brush, tree limbs, and large metal items to the Hal Flanders Recycling Center during business hours.

Accepted Materials

- ❑ Plastic 1 & 2
- ❑ Mix Paper

Plastic #1 and #2

e.g. Bottles for water, soft drinks, juice, sports drinks, mouthwash, ketchup, and salad dressing. Milk jugs and water jugs. Bottles for shampoo dish & laundry detergent, household cleaners.
(recycling materials must be clean)

Symbol	Description
	Clear tough plastic such as soft drink, juice and water bottles.
	Common white or coloured plastic such as milk containers and shampoo bottles.

Mixed Paper

e.g. White office pack & notebook paper, junk mail, brown paper bags & paper feed sacks, colored paper & cardstock. Paperboard & pasteboard, beer, soda, cereal, cracker boxes, paper towel and toilet tissue tubes, & paper cartons. Catalogs & magazines, phonebook covers, and paperback books.
(recycling materials must be clean)



Scrap Metal

e.g. Appliances (refrigerators, freezers, & air conditioners – have the refrigerant removed by licensed technician w/sticker.



Newspaper

e.g. Newspaper, phonebook innards, grocery store flyers **(recycling materials must be clean).**



Corrugated Cardboard

e.g. Corrugated cardboard is a wavy layer sandwiched between two layers of paperboard. Flatten/break down before recycling. **(recycling materials must be clean).**



Glass Bottles & Jars

e.g. Clean glass jars for beverages & food. Labels do not need to be removed. No broken jars/bottles. Champagne bottles and large 1 gallon bottles cannot be recycled. Separate glass by color: Green, brown, & clear. **(recycling materials must be clean).**



Brush

e.g. Tree limbs, shrubs **(No thorny plants e.g. mesquite, cactus (prickly pear, chollas).**

Electronics

Tires: By appointment only

Aluminum

e.g. Aluminum beverage cans, aluminum food cans (pet food) and aluminum cookware (excludes foil). **(recycling materials must be clean).**



Tin

e.g. Tin cans and lids (that are part of the container). **(recycling materials must be clean).**



Used Oil and filters – From DIY

e.g. Motor, gear, & transmission oil & Used paper & metal filters (Disposed of oil containers in the trash dumpster).



No used oil from businesses

The Hal Flanders Recycling Center does not accept paint or alkaline batteries.

- For a fee

Price per tire

- Passenger Tires up to 19.5"
\$ 5.00 ea. (*Rim + \$5.00*)
- Truck Tires 20" to 24"
\$ 10.00 ea. (*Rim + \$15.00*)
- Tractor Tires 24" and up
\$ 75.00 ea. (*Rim + \$20.00*)

Illegal Dumping Abatement

- Clean up of problem locations (Temporally)
 - TDS – Per work order (~3cy)
- Code Compliance – Investigate for possible citation
- Data collection (Environmental Services)
 - Repeat location
 - 1st – Green
 - 2nd – Orange (Dumpster signage)
 - 3rd – Red
 - Dumpster Relocation
 - Cameras
