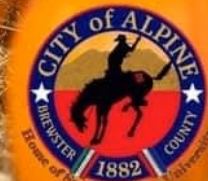

Subject: Search Warrant Execution and Arrest

During the early morning hours of November 12, 2021, the Alpine Police Department in cooperation with the Texas Department of Public Safety Criminal Investigation Division, Drug Enforcement Administration and the Brewster County Sheriff's Office executed a search warrant in the 900 block of East Avenue K. The search warrant was executed as a result of a several months long investigation. The occupant of the residence, Laurie Ann Kirchner, 60, was arrested and facing federal charges of Aiding and Abetting by others and Possessing with Intent to distribute a controlled substance (crystal methamphetamine)

Ms. Kirchner is innocent until proven guilty in a Court of Law.
