SUBJECT: Transportation Day Itinerary for Thursday May 25th, 2022

City staff is coordinating a Transportation Day on Thursday, May 25th from 12pm to 5pm where participants will take the bus down to Royal Oak, Michigan and review their multi-modal infrastructure. Recommended apps for traveling include the Token Transit App for payment and bus tickets, and the Transit – Subway & Bus Times App for bus arrival times. Mogo bike rentals may also be purchased through the Transit App.

Participants may wish to bring their own bike and experience loading their bike on the front of the bus. Given that local busses typically have two bike racks, participants may split up via the Fast bus or local bus.

The following is a tentative itinerary for the day:

- 12:00 pm Meet at Birmingham Roast for coffee and lunch
- 12:30 - 1:00 pm: Catch either the 450 / 460 local bus or the 461 / 462 southbound FAST Bus down to Royal Oak.
- 1:30-3:30 pm Bike, scooter, and walk around Royal Oak and tour their multi-modal amenities.
- 3:30-4:00 pm Catch the bus back to Birmingham

In regards to using the Transit App, the blue dot indicates where you the user is located. You may drag the screen to place the purple dot on an intersection where you would like to find transit. In the case below the purple dot is placed on Woodward and Maple at the Fast bus stop.

The available busses appear in red with the line number, the direction it is heading (eg, south towards Detroit), and minutes before arrival. If a user wants to view timing for the opposite direction (northbound), they can swipe to the side for selected line. The two dots in the middle show the times for each direction. If the user wants to see what the route of the line is, they can click on the bus line number as pictured below.
