### **Birmingham Reopens COVID-19 Hotline**

BIRMINGHAM, MI, November 19, 2020 – With Michigan's new COVID-19 regulations in place through Tuesday, December 8, the City of Birmingham has reopened the COVID-19 hotline to address non-emergency questions about current conditions related to COVID-19. Community members may use the hotline for information about City and County COVID-19 resources.

Elderly, quarantined and immunocompromised individuals are encouraged to use the hotline for services such as bringing refuse containers to and from the curb, or delivery of batteries, first-aid items, diapers, formula, etc.

“We are proud to have assisted hundreds of callers when we opened the COVID-19 hotline earlier this year,” said Birmingham City Manager Joe Valentine. “The City will continue to serve as a resource to our community as we adjust to new safety regulations.”

Residents may call the hotline at 248-530-1805 Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. (excluding holidays). The City thanks residents and visitors for working together to keep our community safe.
