**Name the ‘Little Free Library’ in Booth Park
Contest Entries Accepted Now through November 17, 2017**

BIRMINGHAM, MI, September 21, 2017 – The City of Birmingham’s second ‘Little Free Library’ debuted in Booth Park earlier this summer. The City invites Birmingham residents and students in the Birmingham School District to enter a contest to name the library, which is shaped like a pig.

Booth Park’s Little Free Library is a “take a book, leave a book” free book exchange. Last summer the Friends of the Baldwin Public Library group donated more than 20 books for children of all ages to kick off the second program, which has been very well received by the community.
