Birmingham Police Investigate Rose Room Allegations

BIRMINGHAM, MI, March 24, 2021 – This week the Birmingham Police Department received reports indicating that female patrons may have been drugged while drinking at the Rose Room, located at 220 East Merrill Street. Birmingham detectives have immediately launched an investigation and the community has been asked to share their experiences or any information they may have regarding this matter.

“The Birmingham Police Department takes these allegations very seriously and at no time did we receive reports regarding this and indicate nothing could be done,” said Birmingham Police Chief Mark H. Clemence. “I want the community to know that we will do everything in our power to solve this investigation and ensure those who dine in Birmingham are safe.”

Anyone who feels they have been a victim of a crime is encouraged to come forward and report the incident. “The more information we have regarding these allegations will help us to bring the potential perpetrator to justice,” Clemence added.
