Dear Birmingham Residents and
Water Consumers:

As you may recall, on September 21, 2023 a public notice was distributed via mail, email, newspaper, and posted on the City's website, regarding an issue where proper parameters as defined by State designated minimums were not maintained for water sampled in the City of Birmingham. The Michigan Department of Environment Great Lakes and Energy (EGLE) has notified the City that the notice requirement was not completed or formatted according to State law. The explanation that was provided and the materials sent to you were determined to diminish the intent of the public notice. Please feel confident that **no new violation has occurred** and your drinking water remains safe. We are nonetheless providing the public notice once again as required by law.
