AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 126, ZONING, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM:

TO AMEND ARTICLE 3, SECTION 3.04, SPECIFIC STANDARDS, TO ADJUST THE ARCHITECTURAL STANDARDS TO REFLECT NEW CLEAR GLAZING REQUIREMENTS AND TO PROVIDE REGULATIONS FOR WINDOW TREATMENTS.

TO AMEND ARTICLE 3, SECTION 3.09, COMMERCIAL/MIXED USE ARCHITECTURAL REQUIREMENTS, TO ADJUST THE WINDOW AND DOOR STANDARDS TO REFLECT NEW CLEAR GLAZING REQUIREMENTS AND TO PROVIDE REGULATIONS FOR WINDOW TREATMENTS.

TO AMEND ARTICLE 4, SECTION 4.90, WINDOW STANDARDS, TO ELIMINATE LIGHTLY TINTED GLAZING AND TO PROVIDE REGULATIONS FOR WINDOW TREATMENTS.

TO AMEND ARTICLE 9, SECTION 9.02, DEFINITIONS, TO REDFINE CLEAR GLAZING, AND TO ELIMINATE LIGHTLY TINTED GLAZING
