

## Firefighter/Paramedic

The City of Birmingham, MI (EOE) is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Firefighter/Paramedic. Duties include protecting life and property, fire suppression, emergency medical care, maintaining equipment, apparatus and buildings; participating in daily drills, fire prevention, public education & miscellaneous duties as assigned.

- Fire suppression

- Building maintenance and inspections

### REQUIREMENTS:

- Possession of high school diploma or equivalent;
- State of Michigan Firefighter I & II Certification;
- Paramedic License;
- Vision correctable to 20/20 in both eyes;
- Valid Mich. Operator's License w/ good driving record;
- Physical condition appropriate for the position.
- Applicants must pass the Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) through the Conference of Western Wayne (CWW) Firefighter Testing Program prior to date of hire. CPAT waived for active Firefighters coming from another jurisdiction with fulltime firefighting experience.

### SALARY AND BENEFITS:

- Firefighter/Paramedics with experience are eligible to start at two year pay and reach top pay after two years.
- Starting salary for a Firefighter/Paramedic is \$54,309.41
- Two year pay for a Firefighter/Paramedic is \$73,955.83
- Top pay for a Firefighter/Paramedic is \$85,631.73
- All salaries based on July 1, 2022 wages, annual food & uniform cleaning allowances, & holiday pay
- Overtime available, Blue Cross Medical, dental, vision, 401A, with 15% City contribution, Retirement Health Savings, 457, Life Ins, FSA, Short/Long-Term Disability, Tuition Reimbursement.

### DEPARTMENT

The City of Birmingham Fire Department will respond to an estimated 2,800 emergencies each year. These emergencies include fires, emergency medical service (EMS) calls, rescues, motor vehicle accidents, hazardous materials spills, citizen assists, etc.

The Fire Prevention Bureau inspects all business, commercial, industrial and apartment buildings annually

The Department maintains 2 stations and 13 pieces of fire apparatus. They include four pumpers, one aerial, three life trucks, three staff cars, and two utility vehicles.
