
What's New Around Town?

Rick Gomez Park is Open

The new Rick Gomez Park, 7501 8th Street, is the first newly constructed park in the city in over 25 years! Neighbors and park goers can enjoy almost half an acre of green landscaping, natural grass, baseball themed elements, play areas with shade structures, fitness equipment, picnic tables and a barbeque area. The park has a stadium feel with precast sphere baseballs serving as bollards near the parking circle. Rick Gomez Park is named after a true Buena Park hometown hero. Rick Gomez lived in Buena Park his entire life, and with his wife, Roilene, raised



their children Daniel and Taylor here. Rick was a longtime volunteer in town as a Park & Recreation Commissioner and a coach for the City's Pnut Baseball League and flag football program.



Images Park Improvements

Images Park, 5600 Stratford Circle, recently underwent improvements. Brand new fitness equipment and lighting to were added to the park. A rubberized surface was installed to replace the sandpit and upgrades to accessibility make the entire park ADA-accessible. This project was partially funded with a grant from St. Jude Hospital for the fitness equipment.

Building Renamed to Ruth Walp Hall

A building at Ehlers Event Center, 8150 Knott Ave., was dedicated and renamed in honor of Ruth Walp. Ruth, a longtime resident, was the pioneer of the City's vibrant Youth Theatre Program, inspiring and encouraging youth to explore and flourish in the theatre.



Decreasing Food Waste Saves Money and the Environment

In the United States alone, a shocking 40% of food is uneaten, wasted, and thrown out. We, as consumers, are the largest producers of food waste, believe it or not, exceeding grocery stores and restaurants combined! So, minor changes add up and make a huge difference.

EDCO's new organics recycling program is a massive step in the right direction, but we should also consider and start with decreasing our food waste altogether. Savethefood.com is a wonderful website and resource that offers ideas and solutions to reducing food waste. According to the website, food waste costs labor, resources, time, and money at the end of the day. A 4-person family can lose at least \$1,500 a year on wasted food! So, log on and explore some of the solutions available and let's decrease our food waste!

Even after decreasing your food waste, you may still have leftover food scraps now and then. Here's what can now go in your green cart and be recycled, furthering and maximizing efforts to reduce organic waste.

Do not use any kind of plastic bags (including certified compostable or biodegradable bags) for any type of green waste, food waste or other organics collection or disposal, as they contaminate the compost! All organic material must be placed loosely inside the green container for collection. Paper bags are acceptable. Also, do not put rocks in with organic waste or in the green cart.





Organics includes, but is not limited to:

- Food Scraps: Cooked or raw meat, poultry and seafood (including bones), cheese, dairy products, fruits, vegetables, grains, pasta, egg shells, bread, coffee grounds, tea bags, tea leaves, baked goods, nuts, jelly, candy, snack foods, leftovers, spoiled food.
- Food-Soiled Cardboard and Paper: Paper bags, paper napkins, paper towels, paper plates, paper cups, paper and cardboard takeout containers and takeout boxes (with no plastic or wax coating, and with any metal removed), coffee filters, tissues.
- Landscape Waste: Grass clippings, small branches, small tree limbs, tree roots, flowers, leaves, plants, straw.




