2021 Redistricting Buena Park

Buena Park is redistricting and residents are encouraged to provide input and insight into where the district boundaries should be re-drawn.

The City of Buena Park is asking residents to help shape our community's future as it re-draws its voting districts. In 2016, Buena Park transitioned from an at-large system which allowed city council members to live anywhere in the City, to a by-district-based system that requires members live in specific geographic areas to provide adequate representation for each area of the City.

The City has hired the National Demographics Corporation (NDC) to help facilitate the re-drawing, which will include:

- Identifying “communities of interest” to ensure those communities are represented together, as one.
- Assist in the creation of redistricting plans for future consideration.
- Participating in City Council and/or community workshops.
- Implementing the final adopted plan with the County Registrar of Voters.

Reviewing and re-drawing the City's districts not only provides enhanced community representation, but also helps the City meet requirements of the California Voting Rights Act.

The districts will be based on concentrations of protected class residents, and will take into consideration school attendance zones, neighborhoods, adjacent parks, master-planned communities, freeway vicinities, historic districts, hills/flats, downtown or commercial zones, and other neighborhood defining factors.

Community workshops are scheduled for October 21 at San Marino Elementary School and November 2 at Raymond Temple Elementary School. Both workshops begin at 6 p.m. Mapping experts from NDC are attending both meetings to assist residents with the city's digital mapping tools. The target implementation date for the redistricting is April 17, 2021.

It's Time to Recycle Your Organic Waste



Did you know . . .

Organic waste currently accounts for approximately 40 percent of the material in California's waste stream, with food scraps alone accounting for 22 percent.

Recycling food scraps and yard waste is central to California's efforts to combat climate change. This means diverting organic waste from the landfill where it creates polluting methane due to lack of oxygen and recycling it to make compost, mulch, liquid fertilizers, natural gas, and other valuable resources. Recycling your home or business organics now will support the State's goal of a 75 percent reduction in organic waste landfilling by 2025.

To make organics recycling as easy as possible, Park Waste and Recycling has created a program that includes adding kitchen organics to your existing green bin. This program is part of Buena Park's efforts to comply with organic waste State mandates (AB 1826, AB 1594 and SB 1383 and AB 827).

To reduce odor and keep your bin clean, place a layer of yard waste on the bottom of the bin before adding kitchen organics. For more information, or to request a FREE Kitchen Caddy from EDCO for convenient transfer of food scraps to your green bin, please visit organics recycling at edcodisposal.com or call (714) 522-3577.

What goes into your green bin? Here are a few examples:

- Food scraps – fruit, vegetables, meat, dairy, eggshells, coffee grounds, and prepared food.
- Food-soiled paper – napkins, paper towels, tea bags (no metal), paper plates and cups (no wax coating), paper take-out boxes, and coffee filters.
- Yard waste – plants, leaves, trimmings, straw, and grass.
- Non-hazardous wood waste – branches, tree stumps (trimmed to fit), and scraps of non-treated lumber. Chemically treated wood such as fence posts and decking should not be discarded in the green bin.

Rick Gomez Park Opens This Winter

This winter isn't just about the holidays. Buena Park is proud to announce the upcoming opening of Rick Gomez Park. This half-acre Park is cleverly designed to maximize the recreational potential for community members of all ages.

Named after Rick Gomez, one of the City's most celebrated philanthropists, the Park will feature an engaging baseball theme that reflects Rick's energetic nature and dedication to community sports. Amenities include multiple outdoor fitness areas with individual workout equipment, a children's colorful play structure and swings, a striking baseball-themed grass area with freestanding sports climbers, and ample shade structures and picnic areas.

Rick Gomez is well known in our community for being a highly motivated Park and Recreation Commissioner and youth sports coach for 28 years. He coached several teams in the City of Buena Park P-Nut Baseball League and Flag Football Program, and was greatly admired for being an inspirational mentor, volunteer, and leader.

Rick Gomez Park is located at 7501 8th St. at the end of the cul-de-sac, just east of Western Ave., in Buena Park. The project was supported by a combination of Park-in-Lieu, Proposition 68 Per Capital Program, and St. Jude Grant funds. Construction began in August 2021 and completion is scheduled for December 2021 or early January 2022.

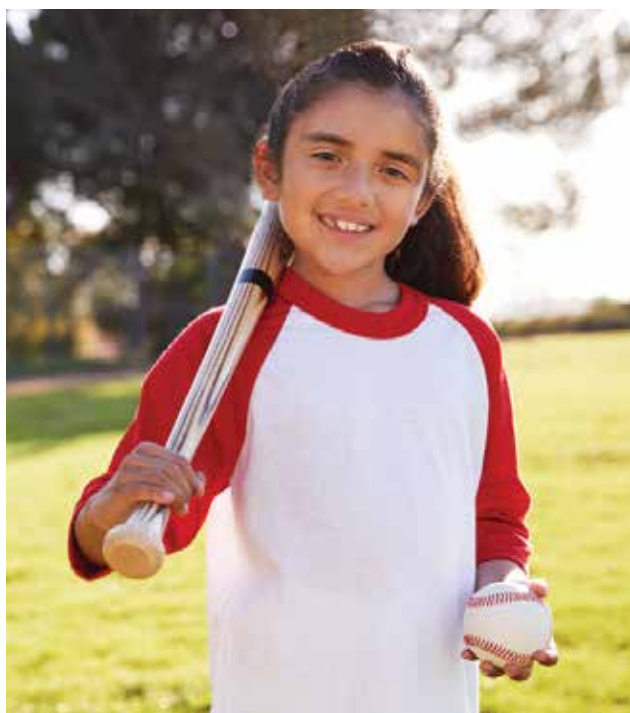

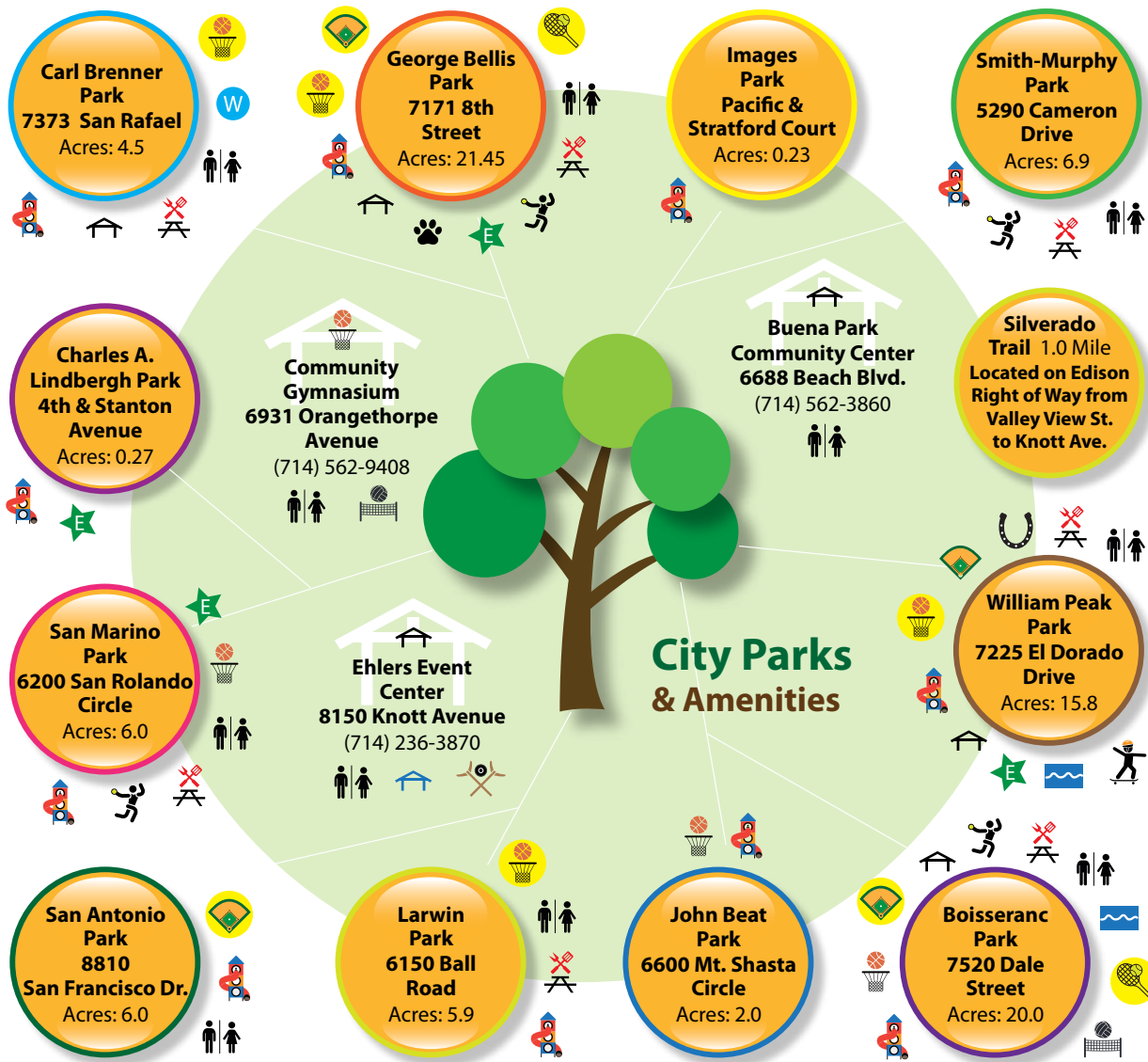
