

Buena Park Homeless Navigation Center Breaks Ground

The ground breaking ceremony for construction of the Buena Park Homeless Navigation Center brought together a partnership of officials from cities, non-profits, the County of Orange and the State of California. Attendees gathered at the site bringing with them clothing and hygiene product donations.

The Buena Park Homeless Navigation Center, a product of the collaboration between the North Orange County Service Planning Area (North SPA) cities, will serve community members experiencing homelessness. The facility, being built with repurposed shipping containers, will provide 150 beds, housing and supportive case management, medical services, and a variety of resources.

"The Navigation Center will provide a safe place for homeless neighbors to seek shelter, be connected to services they need to move into permanent supportive housing, and become successful," Buena Park Mayor Arthur Brown said. "The commitment of our fellow cities to step up and address this regional crisis has demonstrated not only courage and leadership, but compassion towards our homeless neighbors."

The Center was first conceived in 2018 when the North SPA, comprised of the cities of Anaheim, Brea, Buena Park, Cypress, Fullerton, La Habra, La Palma, Orange, Placentia, Villa Park, Stanton and Yorba Linda began working together to find suitable locations for multiple shelters.

On November 7, 2018, the North SPA was awarded upwards of \$12 million in Homeless Emergency Aid Program (HEAP) funding from the State of California via the Orange County Continuum of Care Board. The Buena Park Navigation Center will be funded with \$6.4 million in HEAP funding as well as additional funding from participating North SPA cities. Operational costs will be funded by Senate Bill 2. The City of Placentia was awarded \$5.65 million in HEAP funds for a similar shelter.

Once completed, Mercy House will operate the 15,360 sq. ft. center. Larry Haynes, Executive Director of Mercy House, spoke directly to those the facility would serve. "We see this as a beacon of hope," said Haynes. "We cannot wait to serve you."

Construction will begin immediately and is scheduled to be completed early 2020.

New Voting Options Roll Out In 2020

Thanks to changes being made by the Registrar of Voters, casting your ballot will soon be faster, easier and more secure. As part of the Voters Choice Act (California Senate Bill 450) passed in 2016, several hassle-free voting options will be available next year to enhance the voter experience. Major changes include the addition of more than 200 Vote Centers throughout Orange County, secure ballot drop-off box locations, and a flexible voting schedule.

This is how it will work: One month prior to each election, every registered voter will receive an information packet and vote-by-mail ballot in the mail. The packet will include detailed information on the election, candidates, choices of where and how to vote, and more. Multiple benefits will be outlined so voters can plan when to cast their ballot to avoid lines and time restraints.

As a registered voter, you'll have one or more options that match your busy schedule:

Visit – Vote at any Vote Center location countywide beginning 10 days before election day. Open seven days per week, the Vote Center will feature electronic check-in and ballot system, disabled access voting, voter registration options, and personal customer service support and problem solving.

Drop – Drive through a ballot drop-off location or drop your ballot at any countywide Vote Center.

Mail – Return your ballot via the U.S. Post Office; no stamp required.

Two new electric vehicle (EV) charging stations installed.

New Electric Vehicle Charging Stations

The City of Buena Park continues to go green with the recent installation of two electric vehicle (EV) charging stations at the following locations:

- Buena Park Community Center located at 6688 Beach Blvd.
- Ehlers Event Center located at 8150 Knott Ave.

Both EV charging locations feature Level 2 and DC fast chargers. The stations are located in the front parking lot of each building and are available for use by the general public 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The charging fee is \$.25 per kWh and an additional \$1 per hour after three hours.

The new charging stations were funded with grants from the Clean Transportation Funding Program, the Mobile Source Air Pollution Reduction Review Committee, and the Southern California Incentive Project (SCIP) through the California Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Project (CALEVIP).

Need a Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) charging station? Park Waste and Recycling located at 6762 Stanton Ave., Buena Park, has a CNG charging station available in front of the building's truck terminal. It is available for public use 24/7.




