

Good Neighbor Leaflet Template

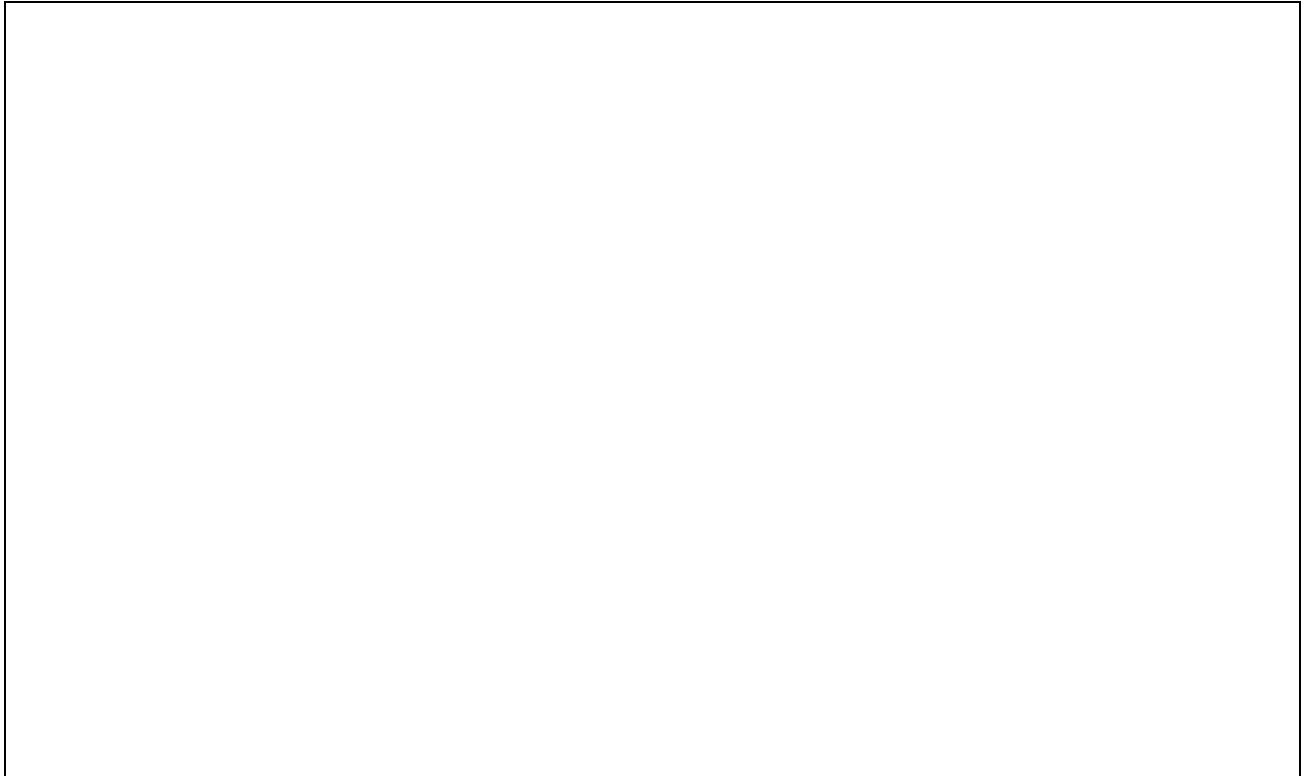
Here are some things we would like you to know about our home, this property and neighborhood:
