

ORDINANCE NO. 41

EXHIBITION DRIVING

THE COOK COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS:

41.01 **EXHIBITION DRIVING.** No person shall turn, accelerate, decelerate, stop or otherwise operate a motor vehicle within the County:

- a. in a manner causing or likely to cause unnecessary engine noise, backfiring, tire squealing, skidding, sliding, swaying, tire spinning, or racing; or
- b. in a manner simulating a race; or
- c. in a manner which causes damage to the road surface;

except when such operation is necessary for the protection of persons or property.

41.02 **PENALTY.** A person violating paragraph .01 above shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

41.03 **RESTITUTION.** In addition to any fine under paragraph .02 above, the Defendant shall pay for all damage to the road surface resulting from which the driver's exhibition driving.

41.04 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication and shall apply to all acts of Exhibition Driving occurring after such publication.


