



## § 142-2 Removal of snow from sidewalks.



[Amended 5-11-1992 by Ord. No. O-4-92]

It shall hereby be the duty and obligation of the adult occupants of property abutting a sidewalk, within 48 hours after the snow has fallen, to remove the snow. In the case of a multiunit building with more than one occupant, it shall be the duty of the lessor to remove the snow. Any adult occupant of property abutting a sidewalk in a public right-of-way, lessor of a multiunit building or tenant obligated by the lessor who fails to remove the Snow from the abutting sidewalk within 48 hours after the snow has fallen shall be guilty of a violation of this Code.

## **Holiday Season**

Holiday Season with the New Year, Martin Luther King, Jr., and Presidents' Day holidays all approaching, we ask for everyone to please be safe. Enjoy time with your friends and family, but please Don't Drink and Drive. Get a designated driver or call a cab. Please stay vigilant. Package thefts do still occur long after the Christmas season is over. We are working to stop them but do what you can to prevent them:

- ♦ Track your orders
- If you live in an apartment complex, see if you can have it delivered to the office.
- ♦ Try working with your neighbors on looking out for each other.
- ♦ If your package is stolen or even just tampered with, do not hesitate to call the Glenarden Police at 301-352-1200.



### **Road Safety**

With the arrival of Winter means <code>snow</code>! Give yourself extra time to get to your destination. Remember the three things that cause you to lose control of your vehicle: <code>Over Accelerating</code>, <code>Over Braking</code>, and <code>Over Steering</code> and be very careful with black ice. If you can stay home, then stay home. If you must go out, please be careful and don't let your vehicle warm up unattended. If it is unlocked, it is illegal and invites car thieves. When there's lots of snow on the roads, monitor the City of Glenarden websites and Glenarden Police Department Facebook pages. If a snow emergency is declared by the Mayor, please check your streets to verify if you live on a Snow Emergency Route. Have a safe New Year!

## **Article IV - Snow Emergencies**

#### § 149-23 General procedures.

Whenever there is one inch or more of snow or a combination of snow and ice on any public way in the City, excluding sidewalks, the special provisions described herein shall prevail:

- ♦ A. Off-street parking shall be utilized to the greatest extent possible by all motorists.
- ♦ B. Parking on the side of public ways with even-numbered addresses shall be permitted only on even-numbered days.
- C. Parking on the side of public ways with odd-numbered addresses shall be permitted only on odd-numbered days.
- ♦ **D.** No abandoned inoperative motor vehicles shall be left in a manner which will obstruct the normal traffic pattern.
- E. Motor vehicles abandoned alongside any public way shall be moved within 24 hours.

- ♦ Accident Reports Accident reports are written within 72 hours from the time of the accident and available for pick-up the day after the 72 hour period.
- ♦ <u>Dispatcher</u> Please call (301) 352-1200 to report a crime or suspicious action in your area and an officer will be dispatched to you through the Communication Center.
- ♠ Fingerprinting These services are offered Monday-Friday, during the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- **Impounded Vehicle** Once you have been notified that your vehicle has been impounded, contact the Glenarden Police Department with the case number to verify that the vehicle can be released and cost for release at (301) 772-3214.


# Department of Public Works News & Updates

The City's Public Works is dedicated to providing friendly and professional service while maintaining the City's roads, parks, and lots, as well as, taking a lead role in many City initiatives, such as managing critical processes like Winter Storm Operations.

The Public Works Department is the second largest department in the City of Glenarden and is also probably the department with the most diverse areas of responsibility. These responsibilities mostly involve providing public services on items such as trash and debris pick-up, landscape and building maintenance, and work associated with improving and maintaining the City's assets and infrastructure like its roads, parks, lots, and green space. The City of Glenarden's Public Works Department has a staff of 7 dedicated technical, professional and operational employees that perform the work related to these areas.

## TRASH REMOVAL SCHEDULE/RESIDENTIAL COLLECTION SERVICES

### **GLENARDEN SERVICE DAYS**

- <u>Monday</u> Yard Waste (must be in yard waste bags or trash can marked 'yard waste' NO Plastic bags) all loose branches must be tied up no longer than 3 feet
- Wednesday Trash & Recycle
- <u>Saturday</u> Trash & Bulk (3 items) All Mattress & box springs MUST be completely covered with mattress cover or plastic. Please note: no request is necessary for bulk trash pickup, please place your items at the curb the night before (on Friday) for pickup.

Please be advised, Prince George's County residents will be required to completely cover mattresses and box springs in a protective plastic covering. Plastic zippered mattress covers are available at many local retail stores for a nominal fee. Goode do not pick up White good items which include large appliances nor car parts & tires.



#### **COLLECTION TIPS**

- Set out all materials by 6:00 a.m. on your collection day.
- Place bagged trash inside trash cans with lids.
- Double bag diapers and pet waste.
- Place all clean recyclable materials inside the recycling containers (i.e. paper products, plastic containers, metal containers, glass containers and newspapers).
- Recycle: No plastic bags, the only exception is clear bags used for shredded paper.
- Yard waste must use paper bags, container marked with an "X" or bundled.
- Yard waste must not exceed 50 lbs. Tree branches and limbs must be binded and not exceed four (4) feet in length.
- Mattress & Box springs must be covered (due to Bed bugs) in order for the helpers to pick up.

## City of Glenarden Call-A-Bus

The City of Glenarden Call-A-Bus service offers curb-to-curb transportation for Glenarden senior citizens and adult individuals with disabilities (within the city limits of Glenarden). This service is for medical appointments, shopping, Senior Center activities, senior clubs, and other trips on a priority basis.

A lift-equipped bus is available for those in need. Please, let staff know of the need for a lift-equipped van when making a transportation appointment (reservations must be made 24 hours in advance).

A minimal \$1.25 fee each way or \$2.50 round-trip is required. To make an appointment call (301) 789-4198, Monday - Friday from 7:30 am - 1:30 pm.


