 - ➤ C. Cross I believe the charter has a six-day minimum before any voting can be permitted. It is concerning to Mayor Cross as a citizen that this legislation was passed November 9, 2020, by the same people who are trying to repeal the legislation less than a year later without it being utilized. The concern is the impact behind the appeal, this legislation is not in the best interests of the citizens or the administration.
 - President Curtis -This legislation has been brought to a public hearing more than six days ago...this is another opportunity for the citizens to speak on this legislation. To state that the council is trying to pass legislation one day after a public hearing and that we have not met the criteria is false; we are well beyond our six-day period to vote. It is the job of the council to work in the best interests of our citizens, there has been several things that have occurred in the City of Glenarden that has forced us to act in the best interest of the citizens to pass this legislation. Unfortunately, there has been abuse of power, so the council is acting in the best interest of our citizens.
