CHIEF OF POLICE REPORT

September 21, 2023-October 20, 2023

September 25th GPD Command Staff attended Senator Benson's 202 Coalition Meeting at St. Margaret of Scotland Catholic Church located at 408 Addison Road South, Capitol Heights, Maryland.

October 4th GPD held National Coffee with a Cop at Starbucks located at Woodmore Town Center.

October 4th GPD Officers were dispatched to the 8100 Block of Martin Luther King Ave for a Carjacking. Once on the scene, the complaint stated an arrangement was made to buy an I-phone at that location. Three juveniles arrived at the location to sell an iPhone. After his friend got out of the vehicle, the two of the juveniles pulled out pistols and demanded the three of them to get out of the vehicle. They then demanded the three complainants to hand over their phones, air pods, wallets, and keys to the vehicle.

The juvenile suspects got into the vehicle and fled the scene. One complainant identified two of the 3 juveniles by name and stated he know them from school. Prince Georges County Police Detective Allen responded to the scene. All victims were transported to Division 3 located at 7600 Barlowe Road to give statements.

PGPD Detective responded to the scene and took the victims to Division 3 for interviews. Detective Allen applied for arrest warrants for two of the 3 juvenile suspects.

October 5th GPD Command Staff attended the Event at Judge Sylvania Woods Elementary School to swear-in the Safety Patrol Officers.

October 6th GPD Command Staff attended Blessing of the Badge at University of Maryland Chapel located at 7744 Regents Drive College Park Maryland

October 7th GPD Command Staff attended Blessing of the Badge at Prince George's Police Department Division III located at 7600 Barlowe Rd.

October 10th GPD Officer was working secondary employment at (Wegmans) located at 9001 McHugh Drive. He and the Asset Protection Specialist for Wegmans observed two individuals in a verbal dispute with a Wegmans employee. Further investigation revealed the female was attempting to conceal items already selected in the cart by arranging them while the male scanned other items. The Asset Protection Specialist followed the transaction on the Wegmans high definition security camera.

The suspects attempted to exit the self check out area, and walk past all working cash registers and final points of sale and exit the main corridor of the establishment with the unpaid merchandise. The Officer and the Asset Protection Specialist were able to stop both individuals without incident.

A warrant check through Prince George's County Police Communications revealed the female had a active warrant out of North Carolina for Failure to Appear which was fully extraditable. She was charged with theft less than \$100. The female defendant was transported to the Department of Corrections to be processed.

On October 11th GPD Officer was dispatched to the 2800 Campus Way North (Bath & Body Works) for a theft in progress. Upon arrival, an employee stated a male wearing black leather pants, a cream color shirt carrying beige handbag along with a female wearing a green sweater and blue jeans carrying a clear handbag entered the store, walked over to the candle display counter, and concealed large amounts of candles inside of the bags they were carrying and fled on foot out of the store getting into a Grey SUV. She was unable to obtain the vehicle's registration, make and model.

October 11th GPD Officers were dispatched to 3201 Roland Kenner Loop, for a reported citizen robbery. Upon arrival, Officers met with four victims (Construction Workers). They reported an unknown suspect wearing all black clothing, tattoo on face and neck pointed handgun at them and demanded their property. The property included Cash, phones, and other property of value). The subject fled on foot toward Brightseat Road.

One of the Construction Workers followed the suspect in his vehicle and lost sight of him in the area of Glenarden Parkway and 7th Street. Prince Georges County Canine Unit responded to Glenarden Parkway and 7th Street for deployment with GPD Officers.

Officers were able to conduct an investigative stop on an individual matching the description at the intersection of Saint John's Place/ Tyrol Terrace, but it was later determined the individual was not the suspect of the crime.

Prince Georges County Police Detective Everett responded to the scene. All victims were transported to Division 3 located at 7600 Barlowe Road to give statements.

October 13th GPD monitored the Memorial Service of the juvenile involved in car accident at the Gold Room and in the 8600 Block of Fulton Avenue.

October 14th GPD Officers were dispatched to the 9000 Block of Ruby Lockhart for a stolen vehicle. Once on the scene, the complainant stated her Ring Camera recorded six male suspects going through her 2015 Hyundai Santa Fe. Moments later, they returned and stole her vehicle.

Prince Georges County Police Auto Theft unit was notified.
