

**Minutes of
Jackson County Commissioners
November 1, 2022
9:00 AM**

Present: Commissioner Matt Reedy, Commissioner Drew Markel & Commissioner Bob Gillaspy

Absent: All Present

Commissioner Matt Reedy called the meeting to order.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited, and Silent Prayer observed.

Commissioner Gillaspy made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 18, 2022 Regular Meeting.

Commissioner Markel seconded. Three (3) yes votes, motion carried.

Commissioner Gillaspy made a motion to approve the Payroll of October 21, 2022 in the amount of \$484,253.59 along with Claims, including electronic checks, in the amount of \$2,403,216.94.

Commissioner Markel seconded. Three (3) yes votes, motion carried.

Reports from other Committees: None

Community Corrections Director, JL Brewer then stated that the department is coming up with a request for use of some of the Opioid Settlement funds. Since no funds have been distributed to the county at this point, Brewer asked Commissioners to consider his request once these funds become available. Brewer stated that if the department received funds, they would be used for treatment. Brewer then asked Commissioners for direction in purchasing a transport vehicle. The current population at the work release center is 104. Currently they are transporting to and from treatment facilities and he would like to have a specific vehicle just for this. Commissioners advised Brewer to try to receive 3 quotes for a vehicle. The vehicle would most likely be purchased using CTP funds.

Commissioner Gillaspy made a motion to approve the 2023 Commissioner Regular Meeting Schedule as presented. Commissioner Markel seconded. Three (3) yes votes, motion carried.

Commissioner Gillaspy made a motion to approve a 45 mph speed limit to be placed on County road 50N, near the address of 5659 W 50 N Medora. Commissioner Markel seconded. Three (3) yes votes, motion carried. Commissioners advised Attorney Bevers to prepare an ordinance for the next meeting.

Highway Superintendent, Jerry Ault presented the Plans for Bridge 154 for signature. These plans had been previously approved and commissioners signed the documents. Ault then stated that Bridge 197 will be moved to the fairgrounds.

Human Resource Director, Jeff Hubbard stated that open enrollment meetings for health insurance will be held November 21-23, 2022.

Auditor Roger Hurt stated that the Commissioners received the October 2022 Fund Report and the November 2022 meeting room schedule for their review.

Commissioners then recessed until November 15, 2022, at 9:00 AM.
