

**Minutes of  
Jackson County Commissioners  
April 4, 2023  
9:00 AM**

Present: Commissioner Drew Markel, Commissioner Matt Reedy & Commissioner Bob Gillaspay

Absent: All present.

Commissioner Drew Markel called the meeting to order.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and Silent Prayer observed.

Commissioner Gillaspay made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 21, 2023 Regular Meeting.

Commissioner Reedy seconded. Three (3) yes votes, motion carried.

Commissioner Gillaspay made a motion to approve the Payroll of March 24, 2023 in the amount of \$510,354.61 along with claims, including electronic checks, in the amount of \$2,507,867.93. Commissioner Reedy seconded. Three (3) yes votes, motion carried.

**Reports from other Committees:** Commissioner Reedy stated there was some conversation in regards to issues with the bleachers in the grandstands at the Fairgrounds.

Tom Goecker then presented Greendale North Subdivision for approval. After review, Commissioners stated that the county does not maintain the storm sewers. This is the responsibility of Seymour City. Commissioner Reedy made a motion to approve. Commissioner Gillaspay seconded. Three (3) yes votes, motion carried.

Community Corrections Director, JL Brewer then appeared before Commissioners with two Peer Recovery Contract Renewals. The two contracts are for Joe Madden and Brooke Nugent. After review, Commissioner Reedy made a motion to approve. Commissioner Gillaspay seconded. Three (3) yes votes, motion carried.

JL Brewer then presented a letter of support for the Community Corrections 2024 Grant. The request to be submitted will be approximately \$1,000,000. Commissioner Gillaspay made a motion to approve the letter of support. Commissioner Reedy seconded. Three (3) yes votes, motion carried.

Sheriff Meyer stated that the Departments Easter Egg hunt will be Saturday, April 8<sup>th</sup> at 11am.

Human Resource Director, Jeff Hubbard stated that he has been in discussion with Beatty insurance regarding the bleachers, in the 1<sup>st</sup> turn, at the grandstands. Hubbard also stated that OSHA training, in conjunction with IPEP, will be held on Wednesday and Thursday (April 11 &12).

Commissioner Reedy made a motion to approve the cleanup of property presented by Conner Barnette. Commissioner Gillaspay seconded. Three (3) yes votes, motion carried.

Commissioners then recessed until April 18, 2023 at 9 AM.
