Commissioner Matt Reedy called the meeting to order.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and Silent Prayer observed.

Commissioner Gillaspay made a motion to approve the minutes of the August 2, 2022 Regular Meeting.

Commissioner Reedy seconded. Two (2) yes votes, motion carried.

Commissioner Gillaspay made a motion to approve the Payroll of August 12, 2022 in the amount of \$495,151.08 along with Claims, which includes electronic checks in the amount of \$304,015.86.

Conner Barnette presented the bid results for the Veterans office construction / remodel – 270 Woodside Court. The lowest bid received - Real Time Renovations, INC \$20,470.29.

Commissioner Gillaspay made a motion to approve the bid from Real Time Renovations and release the project with funding as directed by County Council. Commissioner Reedy seconded. Two (2) yes votes, motion carried.

Brewer requested permission to purchase a new vehicle for the Work Release Center / Community Corrections using the funds from the User fee Fund and to list the current used 2015 Dodge Charger on the County Auction scheduled for Oct. Commissioner Gillaspay made a motion to approve the purchase of new Vehicle and offer the used 2015 Dodge Charger / Last four VIN # 6285 at the up coming County Auction. Commissioner Reedy seconded. Two (2) yes votes, motion carried.
