

**Minutes of
Jackson County Commissioners
February 7, 2023
9:00 AM**

Present: Commissioner Drew Markel, Commissioner Matt Reedy & Commissioner Bob Gillaspay

Absent: All Present

Commissioner Drew Markel called the meeting to order.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and Silent Prayer observed.

Commissioner Reedy made a motion to approve the minutes of the January 17, 2023 Regular Meeting.

Commissioner Gillaspay seconded. Three (3) yes votes, motion carried.

Commissioner Gillaspay made a motion to approve the Payroll of January 27, 2023 in the amount of \$518,452.03 along with claims, including electronic checks in the amount of \$3,263,182.09. Commissioner Reedy seconded.

Three (3) yes votes, motion carried.

Reports from other Committees: None

Commissioner Reedy made a motion to approve the Memorandum of Executive Session, held on January 27, 2023 at 10am. Commissioner Gillaspay seconded. Three (3) yes votes, motion carried.

EMS Director, Nate Bryant, presented Commissioners with the 2022 EMS Annual Report for their review, stating the run report is always increasing in numbers which in the future may result in the need of additional staff. Bryant also requested that Commissioners consider revising the County Bereavement policy to consider the 24/48 hr shift employees.

Sheriff Meyer then addressed Commissioners to ask to use the Judicial Center for scenario based training on Saturday February, 18th. Commissioner Reedy made a motion to approve this request. Commissioner Gillaspay seconded. Three (3) yes votes, motion carried.

Sheriff Meyer then presented Commissioners with the January 2023 Jail reports and the July 1 – Dec 31 2022 Commissary Report.

Conner Barnette informed Commissioners that the current and only part time janitorial staff member had a medical episode on Monday and will be out for recovery. Barnette has contacted Knotts cleaning to provide certain cleaning duties for the historic courthouse.

Human Resource Director, Jeff Hubbard stated that the Jail building and the Courthouse building have recently been appraised. Commissioners advised Hubbard to get quotes for a contents appraisal as well.

Auditor Roger Hurt then presented the Astrophysics warranty renewal for the body scanner located in the Judicial Center. The warranty is the same as previous years. Commissioner Gillaspay made a motion to approve. Commissioner Reedy seconded. Three (3) yes votes, motion carried.

Auditor Hurt also stated that Commissioners were provided with the January 2023 Funds report, the February 2023 Meeting room schedule and the January 2023 Treasurer report for their review.

Commissioners then adjourned until February 21, 2023 at 9 AM.
