

August 11th, 2014





He is proposing to put in 3, 36" pipe with 2 concrete headwalls 10" wide with grass top and that this would be a city paid project.


Travis Thompson is analyzing what the drainage boards future actions can be with the ongoing situations in Oxmoor Ridge Subdivision.




