

July 14th, 2014

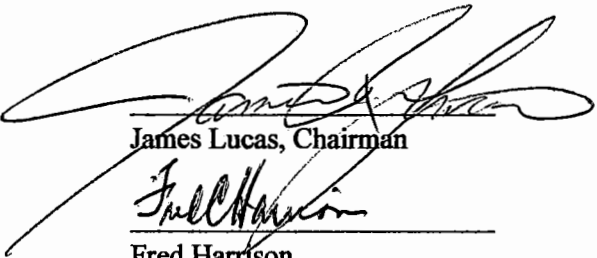
Meeting called to order at 7:04 p.m. Members present were James Lucas, Mark Wiesehan, Fred Harrison, Ray Redicker and Tom Joray. Also present was Travis Thompson, Board Attorney, Daniel Blann, County Surveyor, and Kwin Cutter. Mr. Cutter kept minutes. Mr. Lucas made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 9th, 2014 meeting with no corrections. Mr. Redicker seconds the motion. The June 9th, 2014 minutes were approved 5 "yes" votes.


The Board discussed the first agenda item. Bill Reed came before the board to discuss a bridge replacement on US 31 over the Lucky-Talley drain. Mr. Reed stated that the replacement would be a three sided box and that the total open area would not be decreased.


Michael DeBoy then came before the board to discuss the Meadows Subdivision and for permission for overflow from the detention area into the legal drain. Mr. Lucas made a motion to approve the outflow to the legal drain. Mr. Harrison seconds the motion. Motion carries 5 "yes" votes.

Mr. Blann addressed the board that the City of Seymour was in the process of cleaning the Laugel & Blish Drain to the expectations of the Drainage Board.
