CITY OF QUINCY IN COUNCIL

ORDER NO. 2022-059

ORDERED: May 2, 2022

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Quincy that \$53,000,000 is appropriated to finance all costs needed to carry out the Quincy City Center District Improvement Financing Program within the Quincy Center Development District, including all costs incidental and related thereto; that to meet this appropriation the Treasurer-Collector with the approval of the Mayor is authorized to borrow \$53,000,000 under G.L.c. 40Q, or any other enabling authority; that without limiting the generality of the foregoing, such bonds may be issued for the payment of project costs, which may include interest before and during the carrying out of a project and, for a reasonable time thereafter, such reserves as may be required by any agreement securing the bonds and all other expenses incidental to planning, carrying out and financing the project; that the Treasurer-Collector is authorized to file an application with the Municipal Finance Oversight Board to quality any or all of the bonds under G.L. c44A and to provide such information and execute such documents as may be required by said Board for these purposes; and that the Mayor is authorized to take any other action necessary to carry out this project. All such borrowing shall be considered general obligations of the City of Quincy.
