Background:

Nate Allen from the non-profit, Utah Approves, requested to come to City Council with a presentation from his organization that is dedicated to improving voting methods. Their primary focus is on the implementation of Approval Voting, a method of "Yes" or "No" to all candidates listed on the ballot.

From Nate: "Our objective is to provide comprehensive information about this method and its potential benefits. As part of our advocacy efforts, we are in the process of collecting letters that support the option of Approval Voting in municipalities from city councils across the state which will be delivered to the legislature.

To date, both Huntsville and North Ogden have written such letters, which you can see attached for your reference. Additionally, Ricky Hatch, the Weber County Clerk, has expressed his support for Approval Voting as the best alternative method and has previously attended our presentations to answer additional questions from the clerk's perspective."

Margaret recently spoke at the monthly WACOG meeting and provided some data on violent crimes, specifically domestic and sexual violence, and how YCC supports victims county-wide.
