

The Town of Johnstown is seeking nominations for a Building Inspector. This is a full time position with full time benefits, including NYS Pension. A Civil Service Test will be required at some point.

The work involves making inspections of building construction and repair within a municipality and enforcing the provisions of local building and zoning laws and the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code. The incumbent, under the general direction of the Supervisor is responsible for enforcing state and local municipal standards for the construction of all buildings and all construction components, including, but not limited to, masonry, mechanical, plumbing and carpentry, including standards for materials used and standards for safety and sanitary conditions. The incumbent enforces standards for the condition, occupancy, maintenance, conservation, rehabilitation and renewal of existing building structures and premises for the safeguarding of life and property therein and thereabout. The incumbent oversees the performance of duties of other inspectors including the Deputy Building Inspector.
