

**Sec. 1061-03. - Prohibited conduct.**

No person shall sweep, rake, blow or otherwise cause yard waste to be deposited in the street, unless the yard waste is containerized. If yard waste that is not containerized is placed in the street, the person responsible for such improper placement of yard waste, including the owner or occupant of the premises from which the yard waste was swept, blown, raked, or taken must remove the yard waste from the street or said person shall be in violation of this Chapter.

**Sec. 1060-04. - Storage of refuse.**

(a)All household garbage shall be drained, wrapped and stored in durable two (2) mil plastic bags or durable, rust-resistant, nonabsorbent, watertight and easily washable containers. The bags shall be securely fastened by means of string, wire or some other device to insure the contents from spilling. No bag shall, when loaded, exceed fifty (50) pounds and be more than four (4) feet high or more than two (2) feet in width. Containers shall have close-fitting covers and adequate handles or bails to facilitate collection and shall be not more than thirty (30) gallons in capacity for manual collection services, or more than one hundred (100) gallons in capacity when used in conjunction with automated equipment designed to pick up containers of this size, except for bulky rubbish such as trees, branches and large cardboard boxes. However, newspapers and magazines, if not stored in containers, shall be bundled securely. Cardboard cartons shall be broken down and bundled or tied securely. **Tree cuttings and branches shall be bundled securely in lengths not to exceed four (4) feet and heights not to exceed two (2) feet. The weight of any bundled refuse shall not exceed fifty (50) pounds.** (b)All institutional, commercial and industrial garbage shall be stored in durable, metal, rust-resistant, nonabsorbent, watertight and easily washable containers, which shall have close covers and adequate handles or bails to facilitate collection. Institutional, commercial and industrial rubbish shall be stored in durable metal containers with close-fitting covers, except for bulky rubbish such as large wooden and cardboard boxes. Institutional, commercial and industrial garbage containers not mounted on wheels shall be stored on durable metal racks or placed on an easily cleanable impervious surface. The racks shall raise the refuse containers at least twelve (12) inches off the storage surface. Containers mounted on wheels shall be specifically designed for use with collection vehicles. A container's wheels must elevate the base of a container a distance of at least six (6) inches off the storage surface. The storage floor must have an impervious, easily cleanable surface. (c)Containers and racks as herein described shall be provided by and kept clean and in good repair by the owner, occupant or lessee of any premises in the Village.
